**09-2025-01 RESOLUTION EXPRESSING OFFICIAL INTENT THAT CERTAIN EXPENDITURES TO BE INCURRED IN CONNECTION WITH CERTAIN PUBLIC WORKS PROJECTS FOR THE COUNTY AND RELATED EXPENDITURES BE REIMBURSED FROM PROCEEDS OF NOTES, BONDS, OR OTHER INDEBTEDNESS TO BE ISSUED BY DICKSON COUNTY, TENNESSEE.**

This Resolution is to establish its official intent to issue bonds, notes, or other indebtedness to finance the costs of the Project and other related expenditures in an amount not to exceed Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00). Pending the issue of such bonds, notes, or other indebtedness, funds necessary to finance a portion of such costs shall be advanced from such source of funds on hand and available for such purpose, and any amounts so advanced shall be reimbursed from the proceeds of the tax-exempt bonds, notes, or other indebtedness when issued. Motion by Commissioner Carl Buckner, second by Commissioner Cindi Gray to establish its official intent to issue bonds, note, or other indebtedness to finance costs and other related expenditures in an amount not to exceed Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) necessary to fund Public Works Projects for the county passed by a unanimous aye voice vote.

**09-2025-02 RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE DICKSON COUNTY TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT A \$3,000,000 GRANT THROUGH THE TENNESSEE DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC & COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT TO BE USED TO AID IN THE RECOVERY AND TO FUND INFRASTRUCTURE COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH DAMAGE FROM THE 2021 FLOOD.**
